

Important: Logging Out From LawNet

Please ensure that you log out from LawNet when you are done with your LawNet session.

The Law School is assigned a limited number of concurrent connections. If you fail to log out properly from LawNet when you are done with your session, the system may assume that you still wish to continue with your session. This may result in other intending users not being able to log on. If the maximum numbers of concurrent connections are taken up, other intending users will not be able to log on, and will instead get the “Maximum number of users exceeded” error message.

1. So please make sure to "Logout" once you have finished with your LawNet session.
2. Do not close your LawNet session by closing the browser.
3. Instead, click the logout link found on the navigation bar (Fig. 1) at the top of the webpage. Click “Logout”.
